4. **Storytelling Contests** – Grade I September 27, 2004
5. **Storytelling and Read Aloud** – Grade III, September 27, 2004
6. **Poster Making Contest** – Grade IV, September 21, 2004
7. **Slogan Making Contest** – Grades V – VI, September 21, 2004
8. **Book Characters on Parade** – Kinder & Grades I – VI, Sept. 29
9. **Oral Reading Contest** – Grade III w/ comprehension 10 pupil's contestant
10. **Declamation** – Grade V-VI, September 27, 2004
11. **Culminating Activity** – Parade & Program, Sept. 29, 2004, 7:00 am
