1. I cannot/will not allow my child to attend in-person classes on campus. What will happen?

- Your child will be accommodated for full online attendance. This means that your child will be joining her/his classmates virtually through our online platform. Our Hybrid Learning Modality allows those attending in person and those attending online to attend the same class together at the same time through our learning management system.
- You just have to ensure that you and your child know the class schedule and the meeting link for synchronous classes.
- You are also held responsible to provide your child the technical needs such as laptop/gadget and internet connection.

2. Now, I am not allowing my child to attend in-person classes. What if I change my mind in the future?

We are offering a Hybrid Learning Modality that allows flexibility. Each class has a provision for the in-person and the online attendance. Your child has a reserved slot for the in-person attendance. That is why, if your situation changes and your child has the capacity to attend the in-person classes, s/he will be allowed to shift from full-online attendance to Hybrid Learning Attendance in which there are days when s/he can attend in-person classes on campus.

Similarly, if you give consent for the in-person attendance of your child and your situation suddenly changes, so your child needs to shift to full online attendance, s/he he will be allowed to attend the full online. All you have to do is to **COMMUNICATE and COORDINATE with your child's ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL.**

3. Can my child be accommodated for full face-to-face attendance?

- NO. We are offering the Hybrid Learning Modality. We still subscribe to the limited face-to-face.

4. If my child is accommodated for full online attendance, will s/he have a different curriculum and assessment?

- NO. The curriculum, pedagogy, and assessment will be the same for all students. Likewise, there will be just one set of Academic Policies for all students.

5. Is student attendance required?


YES. Attendance is required in both the in-person and online modalities. Any concern about attendance should be directed to the Assistant Principal. Accommodations will be done for students who are currently in a different time zone compared to the Philippines.

6. We are abroad and we cannot purchase the prescribed school uniform. What should we do?

Students who are currently outside the Philippines may NOT wear the prescribed uniform but can wear any plain shirt/blouse of the same color as the prescribed uniform for the specific day.

7. What are the device specifications for next school year?

Information about required device specifications will be posted on the DLSL website.



8. Will there be different tuition and other fees for those who will not attend the in-person component of the Hybrid Learning Modality?

We are offering only one modality—the Hybrid Learning Modality. Hence, the tuition and other fees will be similar for all the students. Full online attendance is just an accommodation .

9. If my child is accommodated for full online attendance, can s/he attend in-person school extra-curricular activities and assemblies ?

YES, but you have to coordinate in advance with the Assistant Principal and accomplish the necessary consent form.

10. Will there be a schedule of first Communion and Confirmation for students?

- YES. The CLCE department will issue the announcement of the date and details. Students may coordinate with their CLCE teacher.
- The first Communion will be offered for Incoming Grade 3 students. Grade 4-6 students who did not have the first Communion due to the pandemic will also be provided with the first Communion Rites.

11. Is COVID-19 vaccination required for students to be allowed to attend in-person classes?

- NO. Vaccination is not a requirement. However, we would like you to update the non-COVID-19 vaccination record of your child with the Institutional Health Services.

12. Should we provide our children with Health and Safety Kit?

YES. We will be requiring each student to have her/his personal health and safety kit containing at least the following items:

- ★ masks
- ★ thermometer
- ★ alcohol/sanitizer
- ★ tissue paper
- ★ hand soap
- ★ small whistle
- ★ towelette
